

Machen Tuition Scholarship Guidelines

For Bible Presbyterian Ministerial Students

(Revised 5/25/10)

- ◆ Applicant should be under care of his Bible Presbyterian Church, General Synod presbytery
- ◆ Funds are only for matriculated M.Div. students and ministerial track PMP BP students.
- ◆ Scholarship students should be at least half-time resident or full-time PMP.
- ◆ Funds are available only after the applicant has completed one full semester of study
- ◆ Funds are intended to cover tuition costs and required textbooks only.
- ◆ Amount of scholarship is based on
 - ◆ Student Financial Need
 - ◆ Eligible BP students will complete a Machen Scholarship application each term, declaring their liquid and real assets, as well as their main expenses
 - ◆ The Financial Aid Committee will review the application and determine eligibility and amount of scholarship funding
 - ◆ Applicants for Machen fund assistance must disclose all funding sources to the Financial Aid Committee as part of the application process
 - ◆ Students drawing funds from other sources will be eligible for Machen funds after all other sources have reached their limits.
 - ◆ Scholarship Funds available each term
 - ◆ No more than 25% of the fund will be disbursed in one school term
 - ◆ The available amount will be prorated if several students are drawing from it
- ◆ The student's potential for service in the BPC, determined by the Financial Aid Committee
